Highway

Interstate 24 is 6 miles south of Guthrie and Trenton. The four-lane U.S. 68/KY 80 bisects Todd County and provides access to Natcher Parkway and Interstate 65, with travel time of less than one hour. U.S. Highways 79 and 41 provide excellent access to various points throughout the County and region. State Highway 181 connects Elkton and Guthrie.
